## Responsibilities of the Parents/Carers

### All parents/guardians will:

- » Accept the school's aims and values

- » Respect the confidentiality of each child
- » Be respectful with all the school's staff and treat staff and students with courtesy
- » Understand that any parent who harm the school's reputation, in any way, will take the risk of his child's exclusion from the British International School of Casablanca
- » Contribute positively to the school development
- » Support the authority and discipline of the school enabling your child to achieve maturity, self-discipline and self-control
- » Abide by school's policy regarding access to school grounds before, during and after school hours
- » No meeting can be arranged without having taken an appointment and specified the meeting request subject
- » Ensure that your child attends school punctually every day during term time, unless there is a good reason for absence (e.g. illness).
- » Notify the school by email or telephone in the event of absence.
- » Support the school's policies and guidelines on learning, behaviour and uniform, both in School and at home.
- » Attend parent/teacher meetings to discuss your child's progress.
- » Support your child with homework that is set, including reading.
- » Keep us informed of where to contact you in case of emergency.
- » Promptly inform the school of any concerns or problems that may affect your child's learning, behaviour or happiness at school.
- » Support school in the teaching of safe and secure Internet use at home.
