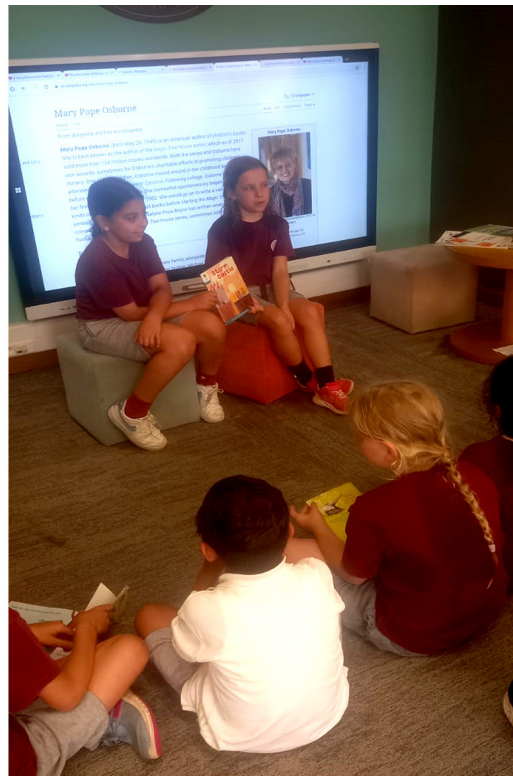
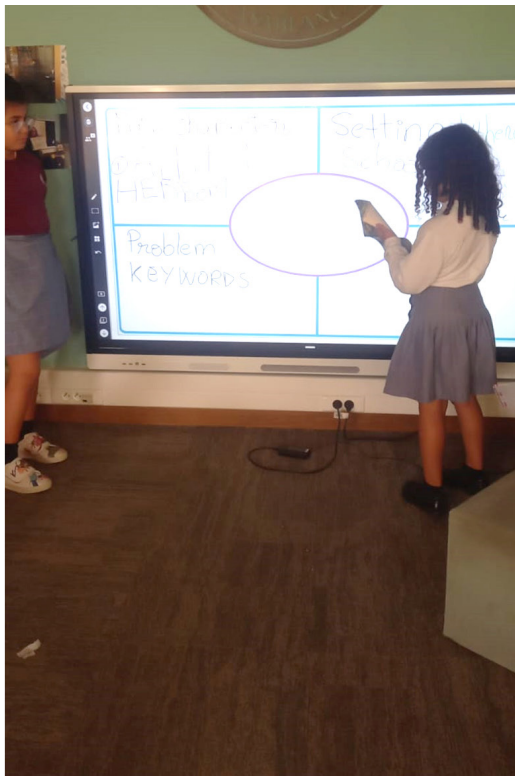
YEAR 6

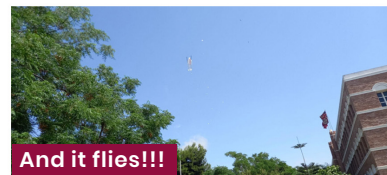


Children & Parents are invited to come to school on Friday dressed in various countries' traditional attire.
